Si une exposition a été organisée pour être présentée uniquement dans des institutions autres que celle qui l'a organisée, la date et le lieu de la première présentation sont indiqués sous le nom de l'institution qui en fut responsable. Le titre du catalogue ou du feuillet documentaire n'est indiqué que s'il est différent du titre de l'exposition. Dans la mesure du possible, les informations reçues ont été vérifiées dans les publications elles-mêmes.

Circulating exhibitions (indicated by an asterisk) bear the exhibition dates of the originator only, regardless of whether other showings occurred prior to or after those dates. When such exhibitions were intended only for circulation in other institutions, the date and place of first showing is given under the name of the organizer. Unless otherwise indicated, the title of the accompanying publication is that of the exhibition. Information supplied has been verified where possible against the publications themselves.
